Close the old town center of Krems, a special side valley of the Danube stretches directly along the Krems river towards the north-west: the original Kremstal. Nestled between steep vineyard terraces and forests, the valley, starting in Krems and extending far up into the Waldviertel, has been known for particularly good wines for centuries. Grüner Veltliner and Riesling are the most important grape varieties, but a large number of other grape varieties also grow on the fertile soils of the Kremstal.

The Ilkerl Luf is a family owned and operated boutique winery with a tradition stretching back to 1688. It prides itself in combining decades old traditions with modern know-how, while focusing on organic cultivation of the vineyards.

Dürnstein is a picturesque ancient city on the banks of the Danube River.
